

Pay for Quality Provider Incentive Plan

Through our Pay for Quality (P4Q) program, we reward you for helping us meet HEDIS® quality measure standards. The goal of our program is to target MO HealthNet members who need one or more HEDIS-measured procedures or visits completed during the 2021 calendar year. Program objectives are to improve targeted clinical quality results, promote safe and effective patient care, and increase preventive care services for our members.

The HEDIS measures along with your potential 2021 incentives are as follows:

Measure	Technical specs	Incentive
Well-Child Visits in the First 15 Months of Life	Members who turned 15 months old during the measurement year who had six or more well-child visits with a PCP during their first 15 months of life	\$30
Well-Child Visits for Age 15 Months to 30 Months	Members who turned 30 months old during the measurement year who had two or more well-child visits with a PCP during 15 months to 30 months of age	\$30
Child and Adolescent Well-Care Visits	Members 3 to 21 years of age who had at least one comprehensive well-care visit with a PCP or an OB/GYN practitioner during the measurement year	\$25
CDC Comprehensive Diabetes Care — HbA1c Control (< 8.0%)	Members 18 to 75 years of age with diabetes (Type 1 and Type 2) whose most recent HbA1C level (performed during the measurement year) is < 8	\$40
CHL Chlamydia Screening in Women — Total	Women 16 to 24 years of age who were identified as sexually active and who had at least one test for chlamydia during the measurement year.	\$30
CIS Childhood Immunization Status — Combo 10	Children 2 years of age who had four diphtheria, tetanus and acellular pertussis (DTaP); three polio (IPV); one measles, mumps and rubella (MMR); three haemophilus influenza type B (HiB); three hepatitis B (HepB), one chicken pox (VZV); four pneumococcal conjugate (PCV); one hepatitis A (HepA); two or three rotavirus (RV); and two influenza (flu) vaccines by their 2nd birthday Note: LAIV (influenza) vaccination must occur on the child's 2nd birthday.	\$40
IMA Immunizations for Adolescents — Combo 1	Adolescents 13 years of age who had one dose of meningococcal vaccine and one tetanus, diphtheria toxoids and acellular pertussis vaccine (Tdap) by their 13th birthday	\$40
LSC Lead Screening in Children	Children 2 years of age who had one or more capillary or venous lead blood test for lead poisoning by their 2nd birthday	\$30



Frequently asked questions

When can I expect to receive my incentive payments?

There will be one incentive payment for 2021. The payment is scheduled to be made in July 2022.

How can I expect to receive my incentive payment?

If you are currently enrolled in electronic funds transfer (EFT), you will receive your payment via EFT. If you are not currently enrolled in EFT and receive mailed checks, you will receive this payment via the United States Postal Service.

If I am not the member's PCP, can I still receive the incentive?

No, only the member's assigned PCP is eligible to earn the incentive.

How will Healthy Blue know if I provided one of the services above?

Incentives will be determined based on claims data received. It is imperative that you bill using the appropriate CPT®/HEDIS-compliant code in order to ensure an incentive payment.

How does this information feed into the monthly *Missed Opportunity Report* I am receiving?

Our incentive plan and monthly *Missed Opportunity Report* are directly related. The incentive is only payable for those members who appear on the report and receive the specific services identified in the report.

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
